Health & Safety General Policy Statement

MTS Cleansing Services Limited (the Company) recognises and accepts the general duties imposed upon the company as an employer under the Health and Safety at Work Act 1974 and subsequent health and safety regulations appertaining to its operation.

In recognition and acceptance of these duties therefore, the Directors of the Company are committed to:

- Promoting the health safety and welfare at work of all Company employees, of sub-contractors working on its behalf, of its customers, and of all others affected by the activities of the Company.
- The prevention and reduction of occupational injury and ill health
- The establishment and implementation of initiatives to seek continual improvement of the management and performance of health & safety.
- Compliance with all pertinent statutory, regulatory and other requirements relating to minimising exposure to occupational hazards.

In order to support these commitments, the Company shall, so far as is reasonably practicable, ensure that:

- Responsibilities for health, safety and environmental matters are assigned, accepted and effectively fulfilled at all levels within the organisation.
- Employees are consulted, and provided with adequate information, instruction, training and supervision to enable all employees to positively contribute to their own health and safety at work.
- Business activities are planned and conducted in accordance with industry codes of practice, and all relevant statutory and regulatory requirements.
- Safe premises, safe plant and equipment, and suitable personal protective equipment, is provided and maintained.
- Procedures are established and maintained to prevent accidents and work related ill health, including the safe handling of harmful substances.
- Hazards, and potential hazards, in the workplace are considered, and controls implemented to enable a safe working environment, and safe methods of work to be established and maintained.

It is the responsibility of all employees to:

- Take reasonable steps to ensure the health and safety of themselves and others affected by their acts or omissions at work.
- Comply with all Company health safety instructions, procedures, and safe working practices, and not to misuse or interfere with anything provided to safeguard their health and safety.
- Report all incidents, potential risks or concerns regarding health, safety matters.

The competence and awareness of all staff is regularly reviewed to ensure that they carry out their duties in a safe manner, and in accordance with company procedures and pertinent regulatory requirements.

As part of our internal and external communication procedures and staff training programmes, it is ensured that this health and safety policy, and associated other safety information, is communicated, understood, implemented and maintained at all levels within the organisation. This policy is regularly reviewed by top management to ensure its continuing suitability, and relevance, and at other times, following any changes to the Company organisational structure, business activities or health and safety related procedures.
